



MEO Instrument Loan Scheme - Percussion

The following instruments are available for loan from the Music Education Otago.

Inventory

- 3 soprano xylophones and beaters
- 3 alto xylophones and beaters
- 2 bass xylophones and beaters
- 4 bass bars (tuned to C G D F) and beaters
- 1 marimba – 3 sets of beaters

Loan Terms

- ♫ Bond: A bond of \$100 is required to be paid by schools (corporate members) using the instruments. The bond will be returned when instruments are returned in the condition they were taken. The bond will cover any minor incidental repairs. Should there be serious damage, those loaning the instruments will be responsible for repair or replacement of damage.
- ♫ Loan Duration: Instruments are available to loan for half a term.
- ♫ Transportation: Two cars are required to transport all of the instruments. The marimba requires one of the cars to have a fold down seat or to be a station wagon. The marimba requires two people to carry it. Please tighten the leg bolts of the marimba if they become loose. This will prevent the marimba from collapsing.
Out of town use: If you live away from Dunedin, the same conditions apply. You will need to collect and return the instruments through your own means of transport.
